

ALTERNATE DOSAGES

Many commonly prescribed pain relief medications help the symptoms associated with chronic conditions, such as arthritis, but they can also result in unwanted side effects. Compounding can provide alternate methods of delivery by combining the ingredients of traditional oral pain medications in a topical gel, cream or spray form that can be applied directly to the site of the pain. For migraine sufferers, pain medication may be administered through nasal sprays or flavoured troches or lozenges.

COMBINED FORMULATIONS

Often, patients take a variety of medications to manage all the symptoms associated with a disease. On many occasions, these multiple products can be eliminated by a specially prepared compound that combines several medications into a single topical gel, ready to be applied directly to affected areas.
